Tap water is of the highest quality. Use refillable containers. Go to *www.refill.org.uk* for advice.

Use paper and cardboard straws and cutlery if you need to. Use a reusable cup or mug.

Use towelling nappies rather than disposable ones.

Take your own container to the shops in Knighton supporting reduction in plastic use.

Buy bars of soap instead of soap in a plastic bottle.

Join the litter picking team in Knighton. (Contact us for details.)

Use a razor with replaceable blades instead of a disposable razor.

Recycle everything you can.

Crisp bags can be recycled in TVEG boxes placed around Knighton. Remember, agricultural feed bags and dog poo damage the environment. Dispose of them responsibly.
