Knighton Community Woodlands Group (KCWG) is local people coming together to enjoy, conserve and enrich our environment. We learn and share woodland skills, and use those skills to improve habitats for wildlife and to allow our members access to affordable woodland products.

We are seeking a volunteer to help us with a simple and time-limited ICT project, and you might be the one to help us do it! We are an expanding group and we need to change the way we manage our electronic files. We need to set up a secure “cloud” filing system that allows our management committee to have a common filing system, rather than different members of the committee holding files on their own PC. At least, that’s what we think we need – you might tell us otherwise. Whatever the system is it needs to be very basic, secure and very easy to use. We would also need an hour or two training in how to use it, once the Corona virus restrictions allow this.

Skills required: ICT skills of a level high enough to fulfil this project and enough patience to train us in its use. You will be supported by an experienced and knowledgeable group who have been running for the past 10 years.
